❖ **Background: -**

The world continues to experience the onslaught of natural calamities at regular interval and with increasing frequency as the days go by leading to the loss of countless lives of people and livestock and the destruction of property amounting to billions of rupees. India has unfortunately not been able to escape such onslaughts. In the recent past it has felt the might and force of natural phenomenon such as the “*fani*” Cyclone in 2019; the Kerala floods, Cyclone Titli and Gaza in 2018, and; the Kedarnath floods, Chennai flood, Phylin and Hudhood 2013 Cyclones, to name but a few. In response to such disastrous events that have occurred around the world, the Global issues on Climate Change Adaptation (CCA), Sendai Framework for Disaster Risk Reduction (2015-2030), and Sustainable Development Goals (SDG) have initiated various steps to reduce the destructive impact of such events on life and property by 2030. Odisha is the first state in the country that has implemented an Early Warning Dissemination System (EWDS). This aims at establishing a fool proof communication system to address the existing gap of disseminating disaster warning from the state, district and block levels to communities. It covers 1205 villages in 22 blocks of six coastal districts of the state which are prone to multifarious hydro-meteorological disasters like cyclones, floods and tsunamis. This system integrates technologies such as digital mobile radio, location based alert systems, remotely operated siren systems and universal gateways. The system helps in disseminating warning communication simultaneously from the state, district and block levels in different forms like messages, voice, siren, etc. The early warning dissemination is fail proof and operates on a 24/7 basis in all circumstances. Kerala State IT Mission has carried out a brainstorming and decided to develop a crisis management system following the crowdsourcing method and to deploy the same in the shortest possible time, following a DevOps methodology. A crisis management platform was developed and hosted and made available to the public available at the URL www.keralarescue.in It was up and running within 12 hours after the first day of flooding. This was made possible through the contributions of techies across the globe who volunteered to code, review and re-code to enhance the functionality of the platform as demanded by the need confronting the state. In this regard, the Government of India, more specifically the Honourable Prime Minister, guided by the 10 points and 6 points agenda, has chosen to focus on the role of higher education institutions/universities for promoting education, innovative technology and research, facilitate capacity development, and their contribution to the decision-making for addressing local risks from natural

calamities to reduce the risk of disasters in India. Therefore, the IUIN was established by the NIDM with the vision to build nation and communities which are safe and resilient to disasters, through education, knowledge creation, research, technology and dissemination.

❖ **Importance of Higher Education in Disaster Management**

New Research techniques and methodology provide synoptic observations of natural disasters at regular intervals that help in better planning and management of disasters. India is prone to many natural disasters like floods, landslides, cyclones, forest fires, earthquakes, drought, due to climate change many changes has been observed in India. To deepen our understanding of the risks due to climate change, it is necessary to integrate research interventions by higher educational organizations, which is important in the endeavor towards risk education of disaster. Communication and navigation systems also play an important role in disaster management with improved technological options. There is need of consistent efforts in this direction as single and one-time activity will not create significant impact. Hence integrating disaster risk reduction in the structured educational programmes and providing professional training becomes essential. Investing in capacity building of various stakeholders to inculcate the prevention approach will have more lasting effect than the investment made in only technological systems in order to reduce disaster risks. Disaster management includes wide range of activities from planning, organizing, crisis management activities, recovering function and tasks related to proper information and communication. Thus it is imperative to develop holistic approach towards disaster risk reduction through capacity building, research and networking of different stakeholders.

❖ **Introduction of the Webinar:**

A national webinar on **“Role of Higher Education on Interventions Strategies Adopted in Mitigation and Management of Disasters in Context Recent Technological Development”** on 17th August 2021 from 2:00 pm to 4:30 pm was organized by **National Institute of Disaster Management (NIDM), Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India in collaboration with Symbiosis Institute of Geoinformatics, Symbiosis International (Deemed University), Pune, Maharashtra** to address role of higher education in promoting research for developing tools and methods to minimizing the natural disaster risks.

The seminar was inaugurated and chaired by Dr. Vidya Yeravdekar (Pro-Chancellor of SIU) and Dr. Rajani Gupte (Vice-Chancellor of SIU). The webinar was conducted with the following key objectives.

- **Inaugural Address by Dr. Vidya Yeravadker (Pro-Chancellor, SIU, Pune)**

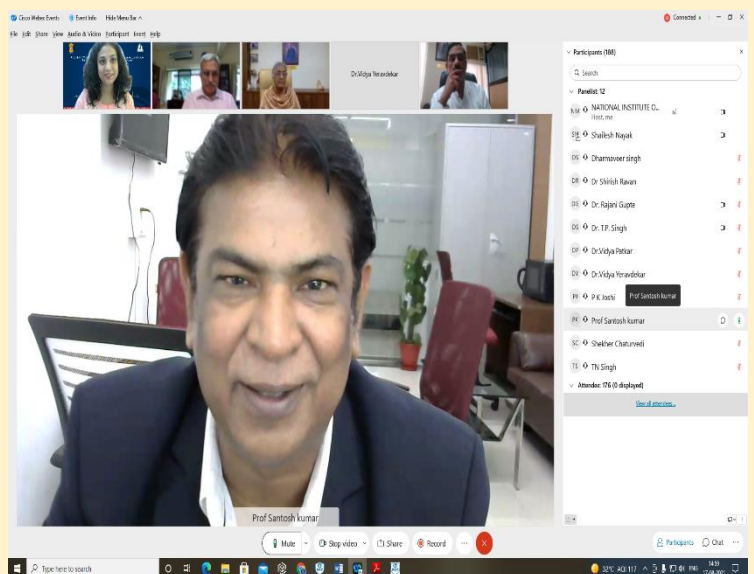

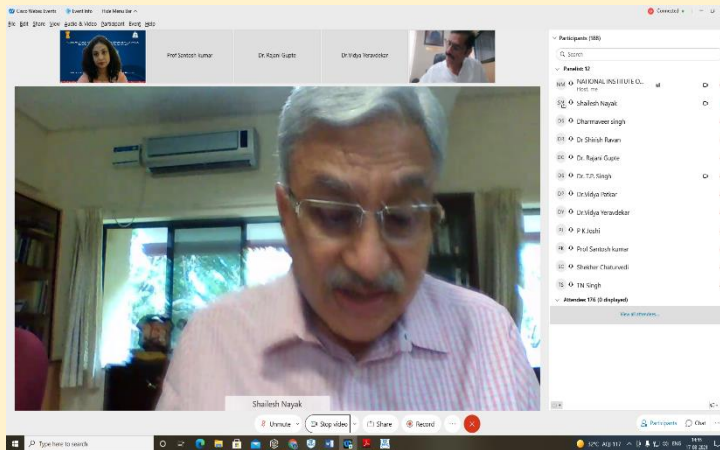
- **Role of NIDM in disaster management**

He gave brief about how universities helping in different areas of disasters and how we can work together to create the knowledge about Disaster risk reduction and to minimize the disaster risk.

- **Overview of disaster and role of educational institutes on disaster risk reduction programme**



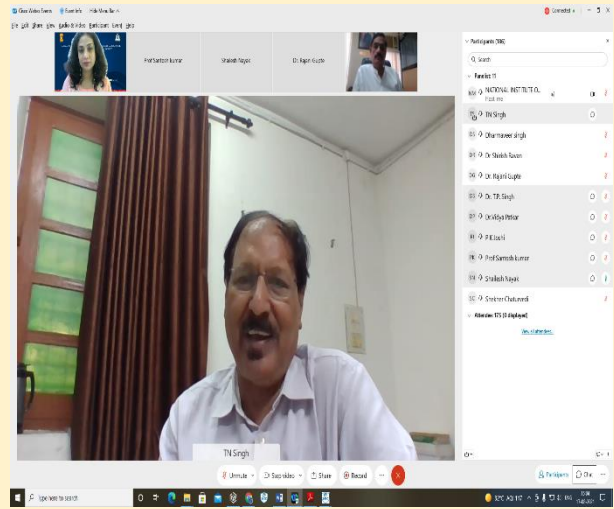
Dr. Shailesh Nayak, Former Secretary (MoES Govt. of India) and Director, NIAS, Bangalore addressed in this webinar how to disaster risk reduction mitigating through technologies generated by the University during few years. In this process of reduction, he has discussed about two major challenges that how

the energies having on climate change to enhance different disaster management such as, flood, drought. And another challenge of natural Hazard represents extremely fluctuation in the average state of earth system. He also discussed about the mitigation process and need to understand the dynamic change. So for better understanding he explained about there is three level of the system those are, Global System, Social system including Governance structure and education system covering all area.

He highlighted about the knowledge of the earth system which is critical to build and effective mechanism for accurate monitoring structure. Socio knowledge of the need is to enhance the end process the real time hazard prediction model. Also The Secretary described about how Geoinformatics becoming extremely powerful tool that all have the understanding about hazard mechanism. In addition, he discussed about the process and classifying zonation into region and many process have micro zonation map but they not integrated the urban planning. What are the difference between earthquake processing and earthquake generation both having the long term plan which is need to make observation to understand about the physical and chemical changes?

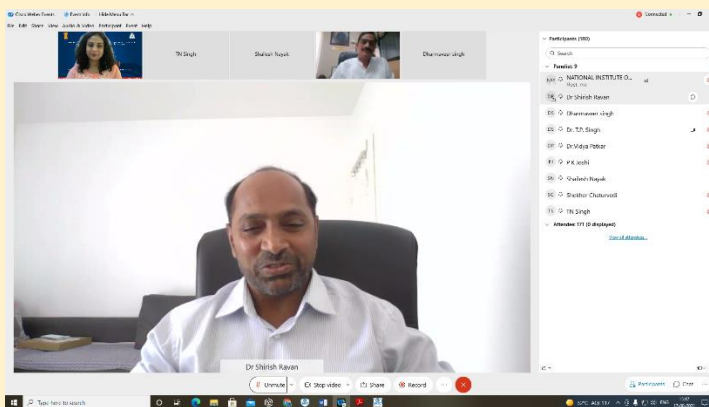
- **Role of higher education sector and challenges faced to implement disaster risk reduction programme**

Dr. T. N. Singh is the Former Vice Chancellor (MGKVU) and Prof. IIT Bombay. Dr. Singh discussed about different aspect of natural hazards and disaster risk reduction for capacity building. His main aim to focus about that education ned to improve the disaster so build the capacity for our nation. Dr. Singh focus that how cultivate a mind sets among the students in a co-curricular and what kind of material we are sending for



the training that they will be concern? Also he said about the early warning system with very successfully and we have the economic loss also human being loss in a certain timing approach. Due to some lack of basic knowledge in an education structure so it need to necessary focus on the reduction management This have the longer effect to maintain the sustainability. These is a need to having a proper systematic and scientific investigation for that we need very delegated and devoted towards man power to bring all things together in Ug and Pg lvel program. Also Dr. Singh has suggested some kind of Disaster programme that mind set can be changed. New education policy certainly gives us the age over the older one where rigidly was deprive about the concern going to one policy to other and cross the boundary.

- **Development of a holistic framework of action for response and recovery during disaster through educational strategies**

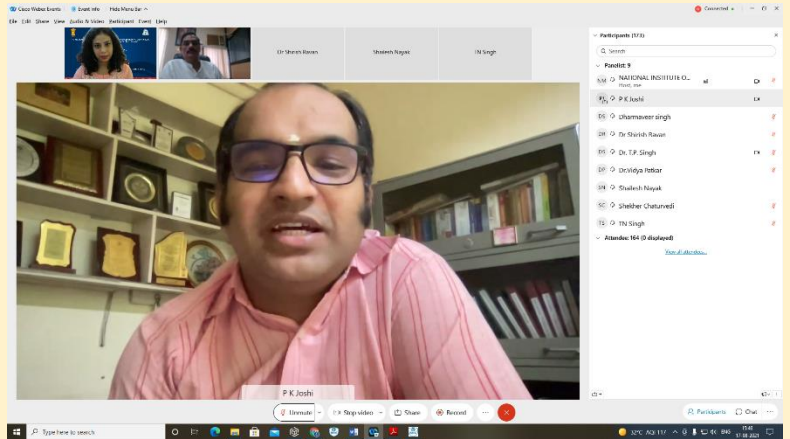


After him, Dr. Shirish Ravan, Senior Programme Officer, UNOOSA, UN-SPIDER discussed about the climatic hazards after twenty years before 2000 disaster impact that loss of economic in a multiple level. He discussed the key concept of any hazards that are we doing our development in a proper way or not? He gave a detailed presentation on the climate change. He beautifully explains how changing climate is responsible for change in sustainability, biodiversity, and ecosystem

Functioning. He explains the primary, secondary and long term effects of flood. He also talked about the kind of measures must have been taken before, during and after the flood. He also emphasized the strategies that farmers can use before flood. He gave a brief about the methods of decomposition of bio-waste which produces after the flood also spoke about the solution for climate change.

Prof. P.K. Joshi, Chair, SCDR , JNU, New Delhi summarised the whole programme and concluded the each sessions. He highlighted that such programmes really need to be encouraged as per the present need and requirements. - The use of education and research must be acknowledged for improving the livelihood of the communities and such studies encouraged and confidence must be shown to research scientist.
- There is a need for data driven approach in disaster management with strong component of research and understanding.
- There should be committees in every institution for engaging people in disaster risk management and having public awareness program for people out of the institution.
